

CHECK OUT THE YMCA AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM!!!

The YMCA is a FREE after school program. It runs Monday - Friday 1:50- 6:15. Full time attendance is required and children must attend at least 3 hours per day.

This year the Y is excited to introduce a new academic period from 2-3:00 everyday. During this time the YMCA program leaders (teachers) will lead students in a variety of activities ranging from “front loading” lessons to service learning projects and math games. The YMCA will be aligning their front loading lessons with each grade level’s Social Studies and/or Science themes in order to give the kids added time to learn new vocabulary and grasp more complicated concepts. (This will happen primarily in grades 3-5th). All the terrific Y staff have returned this year and are excited to begin this new component of program! Following the academic period is Recess and Snack (3:00-3:30), then Enrichment / Club time (3:30-4:30).

Some of the new Enrichments this session include clubs taught by Miraloma teachers, for example: Drawing with Ms. Rosen, Gardening with Ms. Osborne, and Experimenter’s Workshop with Ms. Kirman. In addition, there are lots of great clubs like Roller Hockey, Reading Club, Wacky Science, Girls’ Club, Green Club, and Arts and Crafts to name a few. Recreation is from 4:30-5:15 and Homework/Quiet Reading/Board Games is from 5:15-6:15 everyday.
